Respect for others

Please be mindful that this Pride in Hull event is specifically about creating a safe space for all members of the community to co-exist and celebrate difference. You may be asked to leave the event should your behaviour be of concern to the stewards or others (Including attendees and artistes) this could include:

- Showing disrespect and intolerance of others
- Being threatening or aggressive
- Being incoherent, drunk or intoxicated.

Alcohol and Intoxicants

1. NO alcohol or opened Soft Drinks can be brought into the Pride in Hull event site. Anyone attempting to bring in alcohol or opened soft drink, may be asked to dispose of it before entering the event or risk having it confiscated by security personnel.
2. NO intoxicants of any description other than alcohol purchased on the event site will be tolerated.
3. Bag searches will be in operation on entry and stewards will be patrolling the event site at all times.
4. Alcohol will be available for purchase from the official bar in the Event Site and will be operating a strict Challenge 25 policy, so if you are lucky enough to look 25 or younger, please make sure that you bring an acceptable form of identification.
5. Anyone found to be purchasing Alcohol for under age persons, will result in both you and the minor escorted off the site and reported to the police as it is an offence.

Personal Safety

The Organiser is unable to accept liability for personal damages, losses, or injuries sustained at the Pride in Hull event. Any personal property brought to the Event is done so at your own risk.

General Event Information

Prolonged exposure to amplified sound may cause permanent hearing damage, please protect your ears and especially those of young children and pets.

Strobe lighting and smoke effects may be used at the Event.

Photography and filming may take place at this event. By entering this site you (and children you are responsible for) agree to being filmed or photographed and these images may be used for marketing purposes.

The Event is outdoors so you are strongly advised to bring appropriate footwear and clothing, including warm clothing for the evening and be prepared for bad weather and strong sunshine with sunscreen.

Please do not buy from unlawful street traders. Please keep the event site tidy and use litter bins provided. Dogs and pets are not allowed on the artificial grass.

Smoking is NOT permitted in any internal space or on the artificial grass area. If you smoke please respect the rights of others. Should the outdoor areas or children's play areas become congested please do not smoke.

Access and Parental/Guardian Supervision

All persons aged 14 or under must be accompanied by an adult of over 21 years of age and the accompanying adult must remain within the event site and in constant supervision of those within their care at all times.

Pride in Hull will be operating and enforcing a strict Challenge 25 policy. If you are unaccompanied at the event and fail to provide valid identification when asked, you may be asked to leave the site.

Acceptable forms of identification include;

- An in date photographic driver's license or provisional licence.
- A valid passport (not a photocopy). Out of date passports will NOT be accepted.

On-the-spot checks will be in operation across the site at all times. Please ensure you keep your identification on you at all times and present it when requested by authorised event officials. The Organiser has granted Humberside Police the right to refuse admission to the entire Event site.

Strictly no illegal substances. Searches will be in operation upon entering the event site. Search is a condition of entry and presence at the Event.

The Organiser shall be entitled to confiscate (i) any of the items listed and (ii) any other items which the Organiser considers may be used as weapons, or are otherwise deemed by the Organiser to be dangerous or inappropriate. The Organiser shall not be liable for any loss, theft or damage to confiscated items.

Prohibited Items – Air Horns, Alcohol, BBQs, Cans, Chinese lanterns, Firearms, Fireworks, Flares, Gas Canisters / Cylinders, Glass Bottles, Glass of any kind, Hammers, Illegal Substances, Knives, Laser Pens / Laser Equipment, Legal Highs, Smoke Canisters and any items deemed by management to be dangerous, inappropriate or an accessory to any of the listed items. Sound Systems, Tape Recorders and Video Recorders may only be used with the express permission of the Organiser.

Any unauthorised recordings may be confiscated and/or destroyed by the Organiser.
